

Friends of Rudston Rules and Guidelines for Behaviour at PTA Functions



This guidance describes the basic expectations for behaviour, as well as rules and consequences at FoR sponsored activities to ensure that Friends of Rudston's events and activities are taking place in a nurturing and safe environment where all are treated with respect and kindness.

Children will be encouraged to:

- Keep hands, feet and other objects to themselves.
- Show respect for all adults and other pupils by their words and actions, and listen carefully to directions when they are given.
- Respect school and personal property.
- Refrain from name calling, using inappropriate language or teasing others.
- Not engage in activities that may injure others whether intentional or unintentional.

What happens if a child behaves unacceptably at a Friends of Rudston sponsored function?

Adult Responsibilities:

It is the right and responsibility of active FoR members attending a FoR function to

- verbally correct, or to report to the event coordinator, any misbehaviour by any pupil or parent that occurs at that specific FoR event.
- Parents/carers attending FoR sponsored functions with their children are expected to assume responsibility for their children's and their own behaviour and safety.
- Parents/carers unable to accompany their children to FoR sponsored functions are expected to designate or identify an adult who will be present and who will assume responsibility for their children's behaviour and safety. In the case of a school disco, movie nights etc. those present representing Friends of Rudston will assume this responsibility.
- The corrective action taken by the adult may range from simple verbal reprimand to suggesting the pupil have a short time out to calm down. If the behaviour is significant it will result in immediately contacting the child's parent/carer. The parent/carer will be expected to remove the child from the event.
- At any subsequent events a child may then need to be accompanied 1 to 1 by a supervising adult or be excluded from attending future FoR sponsored functions.

Significant Severe Behaviour:

- Wilfully endangering yourself or others.
- Wilfully destroying property.
- Wilful disobedience of adults attending PTA functions.
- Engages in abusive language or behaviour.
